REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY PAST CHAIRPERSONS COMMITTEE

<u>Issue</u>

Should the Representative Assembly adopt the recommendation of the Rules & Calendar Committee to amend the Rules of Procedure of the Representative Assembly to create the Past Chairpersons committee as defined in proposed rule 7.8 and renumber current rule 7.8 "Other Committees" to 7.9?

Synopsis

At its last meeting on September 30, 2010, the Representative Assembly adopted a motion authorizing the creation of a committee of past chairpersons but also referred further consideration of the motion to the Rules and Calendar Committee for a recommendation regarding the responsibilities of the proposed new committee.

The Rules and Calendar Committee recommends that the Past Chairpersons Committee be available to provide counsel and recommendations on all matters pertaining to the Representative Assembly or the State Bar of Michigan as the Representative Assembly Chair or the Representative Assembly may assign.

Background

The Past Chairpersons Committee would consist of all past chairs of the Assembly, and represents an attempt to provide a ready means of accessing the intellect, institutional memory and experience of the past chairpersons should the need arise.
